

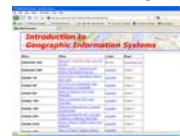

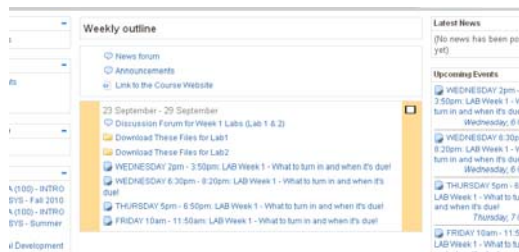
## Lab materials
