## MASTER OF ARTS – GEOGRAPHY – 2022-23 Plan I – Thesis & Plan II - Exam

In addition to departmental requirements, candidates for graduate degrees must fulfill University requirements described in the "Graduate Education" section of the UCSB General Catalog.

Time-To-Degree for the M.A. in Geography is 4 years.

The M.A. degree can be obtained through a Thesis Plan I, or an Examination Plan II. Thesis Plan I: A total of **34.0 units** are required. At least **20.0 units** must be from 200 & 500 level Geography units, exclusive of GEOG 201, 200ABC, 500, 597, 598, and 599. No more than half may be in GEOG 596. Examination Plan II: A total of **46.0** units are required. At least **24.0** units must be from 200 & 500 level Geography units, exclusive of GEOG 201, 200ABC, 500, 597, 598, and 599. No more than half may be in GEOG 596. The core courses must be passed with a grade of 'B' or better with the exception of GEOG 200A and GEOG 201, which must be passed satisfactorily. The M.A. through the Examination Plan II is a terminal degree (no continuation to the Ph.D.)
